Built in 1953 of hand-split cedar shakes and brick, the expanded custom Cape is set on a gentle hill overlooking a picturesque pond and waterfall. Old stone walls, split rail fences and hemlocks protect the perimeter of the beautifully landscaped land which encompasses flagstone walkways, a 30,000 gallon kidney shaped pool framed by decks and rolling lawns, as well as many specimen flowering trees and shrubs - all floodlit at night. Between the residence and the pool is an area of natural landscaping also with a variety of plantings.

The home, designed for all seasons, is especially delightful in summer. Its spacious "L"-shaped screened porch opens to an arbor-covered barbecue terrace and the pool. Here is the perfect area for quiet relaxing and memorable entertaining. In cooler seasons, the vaulted, beamed ceiling Living Room with six remote controlled skylights becomes a dramatic room in which to gather. For the family, there is additionally a fireplace cheered Den, intimate Library and huge lower level Playroom.

The home's 3 bedrooms, on the first floor, are supplemented by an upstairs apartment which is ideal for an in-law or live-in couple.

In impeccable condition, the property enjoys easy access to rail transportation to New York City (about 55 minutes), Interstate 95 and the Merritt Parkway. Norwalk's waterfront provides beaches and excellent marine facilities.
